Automatic Renewal Terms and Conditions

Authorization for Automatic Renewal

By completing your enrollment and purchasing a membership, you agree that your membership will automatically renew at the end of each billing cycle. You authorize the Washington Association for Behavior Analysis (WABA) to securely store your payment method and automatically charge the then-current membership fee plus applicable taxes on a recurring basis until you cancel.

Billing Frequency:

Your payment method will be charged automatically every one year or every three years on your renewal date, depending on the membership term you choose.

Advance Renewal Notice

In compliance with Washington state law, WABA will send you a clear and conspicuous written notice at least thirty (30) days prior to the renewal date. This notice will include:

- The renewal date
- The amount to be charged
- Instructions on how to cancel the automatic renewal

Cancellation Policy

You may cancel your automatic renewal at any time by:

- Logging into your member account and updating your subscription settings, or
- Contacting WABA via email at secretary@washingtonaba.org at least ten (10) business days prior to your renewal date:

Upon cancellation, your membership will remain active through the end of the current paid term and will not renew thereafter. Members failing to pay dues to this organization for sixty (60) days from their anniversary date shall automatically forfeit their membership in this organization as of the sixty-first (61st) day. Individuals in good standing who have forfeited membership because of non-payment of dues may be reinstated upon active payment.

Refund Policy

Membership fees are non-refundable once charged. However, you may cancel future renewals as described above to avoid further charges.

- Affirmatively consent to automatic renewal and recurring charges
- Understand your right to cancel and how to do so
